

West Precinct Weekly Crime Update:

The MNPD strongly encourages Nashvillians to lock their automobile doors, secure any valuables---especially guns, and REMOVE THE KEYS.

So far this year, 934 guns have been stolen from vehicles in Nashville, 18 were taken from autos just last week. The total number of guns stolen this year in Davidson County is 1,193, which means that **nearly 80%** of guns stolen so far in 2023 have been taken from automobiles.

Going hand in hand with vehicle burglaries is vehicle theft. Too many automobiles remain easy targets because keys are left inside or made available to thieves. Just like guns taken from vehicles, these stolen autos are also routinely involved in criminal activities, including carjackings and robberies.

October 5, 2023

West Precinct detectives are working to identify three shoplifting suspects, one woman and two men, who last Friday afternoon entered the Gucci store at Green Hills Mall and took thousands of dollars' worth of merchandise before running out of the business.

As the suspects fled, one pepper sprayed the store causing more than \$50,000 worth of damage to Gucci merchandise. They left the mall in a navy blue Toyota Camry with damage along the driver's side doors. The car bore a temporary tag.

Anyone who recognizes the suspects or the blue car from the attached surveillance photos is asked to call Crime Stoppers at 615-742-7463. Callers can remain anonymous and qualify for a cash reward.

Detectives are asking for the community's assistance in identifying four persons who stole thousands of dollars worth of merchandise from the Green

Hills Mall's Louis Vuitton store on September 14th. These individuals are suspected in other Nashville area retail thefts, possibly including one Thursday night at Nordstrom in Green Hills.

A fifth suspect in the September 14th case, Michael Parrish, 43, was arrested after being tackled by a security guard. He is charged with felony theft and two counts of assault. He was released from jail on a \$25,000 bond.

A review of mall complex surveillance cameras has provided clear images of two of the thieves. Anyone recognizing them or the two women involved is asked to contact Nashville Crime Stoppers at 615-742-7463. A cash reward is offered.

Remember, the police department / sheriff's department will NEVER call you on the phone to tell you that you have a warrant and suggest you pay them money to have the case dismissed. These are SCAMS! These people have been spoofing real law enforcement numbers, but the police will never ask for payment over the phone. If you receive one of these calls hang up immediately.
